Hao Rao

Born in 2004, Hao Rao has started his piano study at age four. By age 13, not only has he won top national piano competitions including Steinway National Piano competition and the Asia young artists competition, he was admitted into the prestigious Xinghai Conservatory of music where he continues his professional piano studies with Dr. Vivian Li. Hao was also selected as the youngest quarterfinalist at the Beijing Chopin International Piano Competition. His upcoming concert engagement includes a solo recital of the complete Chopin etudes Op.10 and Op.25, at the Steinway Concert Hall of Guangzhou Opera House.

Yangrui Cai

Born in 2000, Yangrui had his first piano lesson at the age of four. At the age of 17, he has made extensive concert tours not only in his native China but in Italy, United states and Canada as well. He is a winner of numerous national and international piano competitions incuding Steinway competition and Yamaha Competition, and a quarterfinalist of the First Rubinstein International Youth Piano Competition in 2016. Yangrui coutinues his professional study with Dr. Vivian Li, Associate Professor of Piano at Xinghai Conservatory of Music.

Yanyan Bao

Yanyan was born in 2017, and at age 10, is already a veteran of the concert stage having presented solo recitals in numerous Chinese cities including Guangzhou, Foshan and Zhuhai as well as performing with Salzburg Chamber Soloists. She is a winner of numerous international piano competitions including First Prize at the Shenzhen Lang Lang Futian International Piano Competition, has participated in master classes with celebrated pianists world-wide including Arie Vardi, Gary Graffman and Antonio Pompa-Baldi. Yanyan started piano lessons at age 4, and continues professional studies with Chinese-American pianist Jay Pengjie Sun, piano department chair at Xinghai Conservatory as well as Dr. Vivian Li.

Zhonghua Wei

Having started his piano studies at the age of five with Prof. Jay Pengjie Sun, piano department chair at Xinghai Conservatory, Zhonghua Wei has avidly devoured significant portions of piano repertoire by age 9, including Book One of Bach's Well Tempered Clavier and Mozart's complete piano sonatas. He is the first Prize at the Qingdao Irmler National Piano Competition as well as First Prize at the Xiamen Sterinborgh National Piano Competition. Zhonghua continues his professional studies with Prof.Jay Sun as well as Prof. Dr. Vivian Li at the Xinghai Conservatory in China.

Special distinction : Dr. Vivian Li

Born into a family of artists, Chinese-Canadian pianist Dr. Vivian Li began her career at the age of five with a debut at Guangzhou's Friendship Opera House and has gone on to steadily build a career as one of China's most respected young musicians. She currently serves as Associate Professor of Piano at Xinghai Conservatory of Music in Guangzhou, China.

Dr. Li began her studies at the age of four under the tutelage of her father, renowned Chinese pianist Qi Li and supervision of her mother, renowned Chinese classical ballerina Xianping Su. After a period of study at Xinghai Consevatory's Affiliated Middle School, Dr. Li immigrated to Toronto, Canada where she completed high school and her Artist Diploma from Canada's Royal Conservatory of Music. Following this, she was accepted with full scholarship to Oberlin Conservatory where she did her undergraduate studies with the esteemed French pianist, Monique Duphil, herself a student of Marguerite Long. Upon graduation, she was awarded Oberlin's prestigious William R. Abate award given to the finest pianist of each graduating class. She proceeded to finish her studies with Master and Doctor of Musical Arts degrees at the University of Houston under the guidance of Horacio Gutierrez and Nancy Weems. During her school years, she received considerable additional guidance in masterclass from Dmitry Bashkirov, Anton Kuerti, Abbey Simon, Christopher Elton and Stanislav Judenitch. She also distinguished herself in numerous competitions including prizes in Canada's International Stepping Stone Competition, the Grace Welsh International Piano Competition and San Antonio International Competition and in concerts including one performance of Ravel's G major piano concerto which left the revered pianist Abbey Simon exclaiming, "She played like my friends of the old generation past."

In 2005, Dr. Li returned to her childhood home of Guangzhou to join the piano faculty of Xinghai Conservatory. Her students routinely go on to study in major conservatories across the world and take prizes in important competitions nationwide and abroad. She is also highly sought after as an adjudicator in major Chinese piano competitions and as a regular contributor to China's premier piano magazine Piano Artistry. Dr. Li maintains an active concert schedule of solo, chamber and concerto performances both in China and abroad. She is also regular guest faculty at Italy's Maccagno Piano Days Festival and the Beijing Central Conservatory International Chamber Music Festival.

Alexander Preiss
